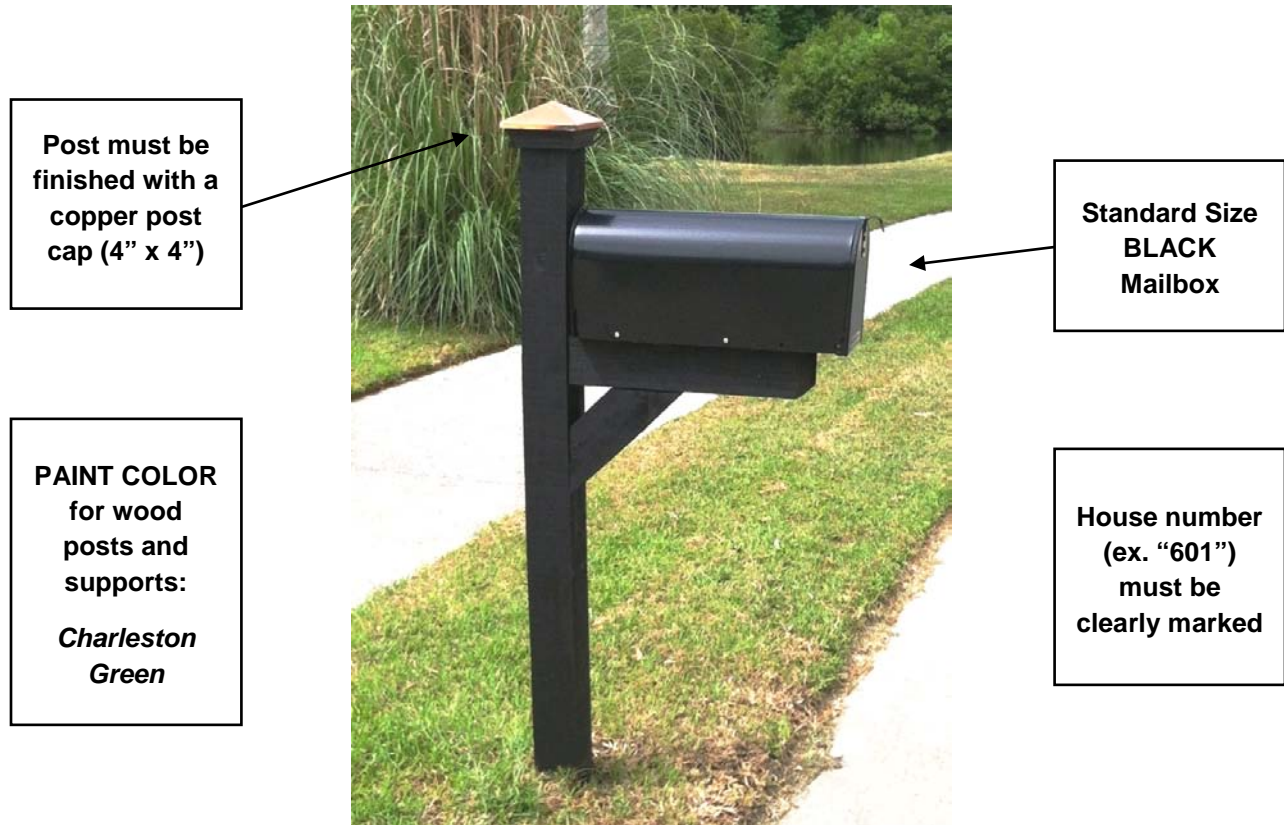


ACC Approved Mailbox Specifications

SECTION 8. DELIVERY RECEPTACLES AND PROPERTY IDENTIFICATION MARKERS. The Architectural Control Committee shall have the right to approve the location, color, size, design, lettering and all other particulars of receptacles for the receipt of mail, newspapers or similarly delivered materials, and of name signs for such receptacles, as well as property identification markers.

- Article VII, Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, Restrictions, and Easements for Sienna at Grand Oaks

All mailboxes in Sienna must meet the specifications below. Homeowners are responsible for maintaining mailboxes in good repair.



Additional specifications set forth by the United States Postal Service:

- The bottom of the box should be between 41 to 45 inches above the road surface.
- Names on mailboxes should be at least 1 inch high.
- The mailbox door should be set back 6 to 8 inches from the front face of the curb or road's edge.
- Advertising on a mailbox or its supporting post is prohibited.
- Contact your local post office for approval before moving a mailbox or mailbox support.
