



TIDAL WALK SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The purpose of these rules is to assure safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities, and to maximize the enjoyment of the pool by all owners and residents. Every resident is requested to read them carefully, and parents are urged to make sure that their children understand the rules and obey the person who is responsible for enforcing them.

I. GENERAL

Persons using the pool or pool area do so at their own risk and sole responsibility. The Association and Management assume no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use, or for loss or damage to personal property.

Hours of operation are from 9am until 9 pm. There is no night swimming past 9PM and you must leave the pool area by 9PM

II. POOL USAGE

There are no lifeguards on duty. "SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK"

All swimmers must shower before entering the pool and/or spa.

Children who are not toilet trained must swim diapers while in the pool.

Running, pushing, wrestling or undue disturbance in or about the pool / spa area is prohibited.

Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult 18 or older unless special permission is given by Management Company.

No pets, wheeled vehicles other than wheel chairs, baby carriages, or street footwear will be permitted in the pool area. Registered service dogs are permitted.

No spouting of water or other unsanitary actions will be permitted.

No persons with infectious or communicable diseases, sores or bandages will be admitted.

No abusive language or improper behavior will be tolerated; nor will excessive noise or music which interferes with the comfort and enjoyment of the facility by other users.

NO GLASS containers may be brought into the pool area. If broken glass is found in the pool area, the pool will have to be immediately closed and drained.

In the event of a storm with thunder you must leave the pool until the storm passes.

In the event of a fecal accident please get out of the pool immediately and call the pool company the number is listed on the sign. The pool may have to be temporarily closed and re-open when deemed safe.

Trash must be placed in the receptacles provided.

So as not to disturb others, individuals must use headphones or an ear piece to listen to radios, televisions, or music.
